



Project 5 Add colour to façades

Façades can also feature colour in addition to white, giving buildings individual character. The selected colours should blend in with the building and the surrounding area. The colours of roof tiles or the base section also form part of the overall effect in a free-standing building, for example. Colours on adjacent façades should also be taken into account on terraced buildings or semi-detached houses. A matching colour should be selected.

Colour highlights

Touches of colour can enhance architecture. Colour in selected parts of the façade and highlighted bay windows, shear walls or entrance areas give the façade added expression and character.



Colour combination

A tonal combination is simple and reliable, fusing a colour's light and dark shades to achieve a harmonious overall appearance.



Façade and base colour scheme

Two aspects come into consideration when choosing the base colour: function and appearance. The base runs along a building's lower floor and easily accumulates dirty. It makes sense to paint the base in a darker colour than the façade.

TIP

Tint the rendering base with the same colour as the rendering to produce an accomplished, consistent effect.
